


Registering MonitorMyMac

After downloading MonitorMyMac and deciding that you would like a full working copy, you can purchase this directly at the following web address:

<http://www.monitormymac.co.uk>

Once you have done this we are automatically notified of your purchase and a User Name and Serial Number are sent out to you via email. The Serial Number is tied to your Name and the two must be used in conjunction.

When you receive the serial number email you should launch MonitorMyMac and access the Preferences menu item.



The User Name and Serial Number that you received in your email from Arten Science should be entered into the appropriate fields on the Preferences window. To avoid typing errors we suggest you Copy / Paste the information.

If the information is correct the product is then fully licensed. Keep the email from Arten Science safe as you will need it should you need to reinstall in future on a new computer.

Our licensing allows one purchase to be installed on two computers that you own, for example your desktop and also your laptop. Please respect our efforts and purchase additional licenses if you need to install on multiple computers. We also offer family licenses (up to 5 users) and site licenses for corporations (unlimited single site usage).

Introduction

MonitorMyMac is an application that performs screenshots and captures images from your webcam at timed intervals. These images are saved on your hard disk or a remote network device. In addition these images can be automatically uploaded to an FTP Server.

- See what happened on your computer, or in your office / room when you were absent
- Verify that your children are not doing something they shouldn't be on their computer
- Monitor your Goldfish / Bird / Tortoise while you are on holiday
- Capture an image of the person stealing your computer
- Provide a visual record of what you were doing and when - ideal for billing those 'lost hours'
- Create a Quicktime Movie of the days images as a visual journal
- and lots more ...



Quick Start

After downloading, unzip the file. Depending on your browser settings your operating system may do this automatically for you. Drag the file / folder to a convenient location on your hard disk. Double click the MonitorMyMac file to launch the program.

You will see the MonitorMyMac main screen.



Click Start to activate the screen captures.

Click Pause to Pause the capturing.

Capture Now performs an immediate capture.


To take full advantage of everything that MonitorMyMac has to offer you need to configure the Preferences. See the next Section.

Configure the Preferences

Open the Preferences window from the MonitorMyMac menu. You need to setup the Preferences to take full advantage of MonitorMyMac.

The Preferences are split into sections accessed using the Tab Menu.

Prefs: General



Check for Updates at Startup

If this box is checked then MonitorMymac will inform you whenever a new version is released, and give you the opportunity to download it.

Hide Window on Startup

If checked then the main window will not be displayed and the program will start capturing automatically. This option is required if using the Full Stealth Version

Use Screen Effects

If checked then MonitorMyMac uses various screen effects when closing windows, pretty, but not essential.

Prefs: Images




Image Interval

This is the delay, in seconds, between images being captured.

Image Folder

Click the Choose button to navigate to the folder or drive where you wish the captured images to be stored. The path will then be displayed.

Quality

The Image Quality, between 75 and 300.

Note: Images taken at the higher resolutions take up significantly more disk space, and if uploading to an FTP Server, will take significantly longer.


Prefs: Speech



if you have the Use Speech checkbox checked, then you can get MonitorMyMac to speak a warning three seconds before the images are captured.

In addition, when the image is taken you can choose the sentence that you would like MonitorMyMac to speak.


Prefs: Capture



Camera Image Size

You have three choices of image size for the photographs taken by the webcam.

The following three checkboxes determine whether you capture the webcam only, the screens only or both. In addition you can make MonitorMyMac capture only the main screen when used in a dual monitor environment.

Prefs: FTP

If you wish for your captured images to be automatically uploaded to an FTP Server, check the Use FTP checkbox and fill in the following details:

Server and Path, Logon Name and Password.

Viewing the Captured Images

Version 1.1.0 introduced the capability for MMM to create HTML files which contain a link to the latest captured images.

Two files are created (assuming you have set the Preferences to capture both Screen and Webcam), the files are named:

mmm_latest_webcam.html


and

mmm_latest_screenshot.html

These files are created and stored locally with your images as well as being automatically uploaded to your FTP site (if you are using the FTP capability).

In practical terms what this gives you is the capability to bookmark these files and view the latest webcam or screen captures from iPhone, Windows Mobile Device, Netbook, Browser or any other device that can display webpages and has access to your FTP site over the internet.


This is much easier and quicker than manually looking at the directory listings to establish the latest images. Although you can of course still do this should you wish to.



As you can see the webpage that is created is Date and Time stamped so that you are always aware of when camera image / screenshot you are viewing, was taken.

Menu Option: Create Slideshow Movie / Archive

Selecting this menu option opens the window shown below:




This screen allows you to select individual images and create a Quicktime movie from those selected images, to do this use the Create Movie button.

The Archive button is will collect all the images in your image folder, create another folder called Archive_Date_Time and place your images within. In addition MonitorMyMac will collate all the images together in Date / Time order and create a Quicktime Slideshow / Movie of them.

Menu Option: Image Viewer

Selecting this menu option opens the window shown below:



Using this screen you can select any of your captured images and view them. You can also zoom in and out of the image using the buttons.
