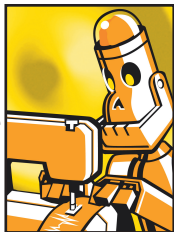

Record, edit, and add effects to audio



## Stitch Help

Stitch is an automation tool that does all the dirty work of combining multiple audio files together with none of the hassle. Cross-fade, add silence, reorder audio, and add gaps to as many files as need!



## Audio Files

Click the  button to add audio files or a folder of files to the list of audio to process. You can also drag files or and folders into the window to clean multiple files at once. Click the  button to remove items from the list.

Use the  and  buttons to change the order in which your files will be joined. You can select groups of files with the shift or command keys to change the order of multiple items at once.



## Joining

- ② You can fade smoothly between audio files with the “Cross-fade Audio” feature. Use the cross-fade slider to adjust how long the fade between each file will be. You can set this anywhere between 0 seconds (no fade) to 10 seconds (a very long fade). This will make the edit from one file to the other “smoother” and will create a nice flow to your audio.
- ② Enabling “Gap Between Audio” will insert the specified amount of silence between each piece of audio. You can combine this with cross-fading to fade out audio, have a moment of silence, and then fade into the next piece of audio.
- ② The “Sound Check” feature is useful for joining pieces of audio that are at different volume levels. Enable Sound Check to re-balance the levels of all of your audio files so they’re more similar.



## Save Location & Format

By default, Stitch saves mixed audio to the Desktop, but you can select the Documents folder as your save folder or Other, which will let you choose any folder you like.

Files are saved into a folder called “Stitched Audio” inside the location you select.

🔊 **Audio Formats** lets you choose from 4 sound formats: AIFF, MP3, MP4 (AAC), and WAVE audio. You can also choose the quality, when applicable. Higher bitrates will result in higher quality, but will also increase the size of the mixed file.
